The Planning Board held a public hearing on October 15, 2019 to consider the following application:

Case # 19-09-19: Application submitted by David Driscoll as agent for Rockywold Deephaven of 18 Bacon Rd., tax map 219-009-000, request a site plan review to rebuild a septic system, enlarge and reconstruct tennis court, and enlarge the access drive to tennis court, located in the General Residential District, in accordance with the Town of Holderness Site Plan Regulations.

Discussion: Discussion centered on the content of the water mains coming from the laundry (effluent waster and gray water); both the Town and the State have approved the septic; the lagoon (it is a mini-waste water treatment plant); the new building (approved in 2015, but never built); the wetlands (have variance from the ZBA)
