3) Programs –

- Most programs are continuing along just fine. However, there was an injury in the volleyball
 Program. A player was hit in the face with the ball resulting in a mild concussion and
 bruising. Wendy was made aware of this a week after the incident and she has made
 sure an incident report has been filed. The accident occurred as a result of one player
 playing using competitive rules versus recreation rules. Clarification of the rules will be
 made.
- Summer Escape
 - Enrollment is well underway with 8-12 enrolled for every session.
 - Wendy has sent out re-enrollment forms and the USB drive to the families of previous Campers and will now release enrollment materials at out-of-town locations.
 - The Board considered the purchase of a Gaga Court for Summer Escape. Amanda heartily endorsed the purchase. The Board agreed to the purchase using funds from the Revolving Account.
 - Wendy mentioned that she has received a request for a military discount on tuition for Summer Escape. The Board discussed this for some time and decided on the following: 1) ask Michael Capone if the Town offers any military related discounts on taxes, etc., and to ask advice from Michael. 2) If there is no Town policy the Board decided to consider having the families request financial aid from our Scholarship Fund. The Board asked Wendy to report back to us at our April meeting and we will continue the discussion then.
- 4) Beach Update-
 - Swim Instructor Wendy is still in search of a person to take on this task. So far all leads have not worked out.
