NOTICE OF DECISION**

The Holderness Zoning Board of Adjustment conducted a public hearing on July 11, 2023 to consider the following application:

Application submitted by VHB agent for PSNH – Eversource requesting a special exception under Section 900.1 and Sections 300.4, 300.5 and 300.6 of the Town of Holderness Zoning District for the 343 Distribution Line Structure Replacement Project within the Pemigewasset River Overlay District and the Flood Hazard District.

The following action was taken at the meeting on September 12, 2023:

Motion: “to approve the special exception request as submitted by the applicant.”

FINDING OF FACTS: The applicant presented sufficient evidence in their application that the proposed temporary impacts due to replacement of a single transmission line pole meet the criteria for a special exception.


